Dear Mr. Haven:

This letter is to confirm that the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) received the Tahoe Transportation District's (TTD) revised Title VI program on September 9, 2011 to replace the Title VI program that expired on August 19, 2011. This submission is required pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; Title 49, Chapter 53, Section 5332 of the United States Code; and the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Circular 4702.1A, "Title VI Program Guidelines for Federal Transit Administration Recipients," dated May 13, 2007.

We have reviewed your program and determined that it now meets the requirements set out in the FTA's Title VI Circular, 4702.1A. Please be aware that on August 28, 2012, FTA published a notice in the Federal Register announcing changes to the Title VI Circular (4702.1B). That Circular went into effect Monday, October 1, 2012. After that date, all Title VI programs submitted to FTA must comply with the revised Circular (4702.1B), which is available on FTA's website: www.fta.dot.gov. In order to facilitate the orderly transition from the old Title VI Circular (4702.1A) to the revised Title VI Circular (4702.1B), we have implemented a standardized submission cycle and expiration dates for Title VI programs submitted under the revised Circular. Please plan to submit a Title VI program by October 1, 2014. Your Title VI program will expire 60 days after the due date, on November 30, 2014. If we have not received all required information by the time your Title VI program expires, TTD may experience delays in processing grants or draw-down restrictions.

Title VI programs should be submitted by attaching them to your Recipient Profile in FTA's TEAM-Web. Please delete any version of the program in TEAM that this submission is replacing. When saving the document in TEAM, include the current date in the file name so we know we are reviewing the most recent correction/submission. For example: "Title VI Program submitted 4-1-12."
