Page 5 – Item 3.c.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Typically a technical lead on a program management assignment, working under a licensed CPM, would not need to be licensed since they are not the engineer of record for design. Does this section only apply when design is required by the program management discipline lead? What is an example of “when relevant”? If this is required, would it be appropriate to allow time for an individual to obtain reciprocity?	The selected firm will be given adequate notice to identify specific license requirements for task orders when necessary. It is not required to identify every potential technical lead that may fall under this contract for services, but instead have access to broader skillsets than the CPM. If the CPM, as the engineer of record, is adequate for a specific study, then no additional license is required.
