



**NOTICE OF  
PROPOSED TRANSIT POLICY CHANGES AND  
PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

Pursuant to TTD Transit Policy, this notice solicits public comment before approving any fare increase or major service reduction. The public comment period commences on April 16, 2018 and closes on May 11, 2018.

The public hearing will be held on **May 11, 2018 at 9:30 a.m. at 128 Market St., Stateline, NV.**

Proposed fare and policy changes are outlined below.

**Demand Response:**

- Consolidate the Demand Response service area to a one-mile corridor from fixed routes, more consistent with ADA complementary paratransit
- Increase the automatic age eligibility to 65 and older
- Persons currently under 65 years that are already qualified and maintain their eligibility uninterrupted will not have to wait until they reach 65 years to continue to ride
- Discontinue general public access to the complementary paratransit system

**Fixed Route:**

- Limit the discounted fare to adults 65 and over, TTD Demand Response cardholders, Medicare cardholders with government-issued photo ID, and veterans with a service connected disability
  - Medi-Cal and Medicaid cardholders will no longer receive a reduced fare
- Discontinue youth fare; age 4 and under ride free; ages 5 through 64 ride at full fare
- Raise Emerald Bay Shuttle fare to \$4.00 per person (\$2.00 reduced fare)
- Free transfers on routes 19x and 20x to passengers with a valid transfer from DART or JAC

**Other Transit Changes:**

- Discontinue Specialized Transportation Service (STS) regional pilot program, no later than September 30, 2018
- Discontinue Mobility Management program, no later than September 30, 2018
- Maximum occupied wheelchair lift and ramp capacity is 600 pounds
